Directions:

1. Print this card for each household member and one for each emergency kit.

2. Cut out the card along the dotted lines.

3. Write in the contact information for each household member, such as work, school and cell phone numbers. If you need additional space, use the back side of the card.

3. Fold the card so it fits in your pocket, wallet or purse.

FOLD

4. Carry your card with you so it is available in the event of a disaster or other emergency when you will want to contact each other. Also keep one in your emergency kit stored in a plastic bag to prevent water damage.
